



PRESENTATION EVALUATION GRID
IR4457 MIGRATION POLITICS

The following presentation evaluation grid is used by the students to grade their peers' presentation in class. The final presentation grade of a student is determined according to the average grade given by the other students. If a presentation remains below the class average (calculated for the all semester) then the student gets one step up/down (-/+) of his/her final letter grade.

Example:

Assume that a student's presentation was graded as 90 (average) by the other students. The class average for the whole semester is 80. The student's final grade was B, then the final grade is increased to B+.
